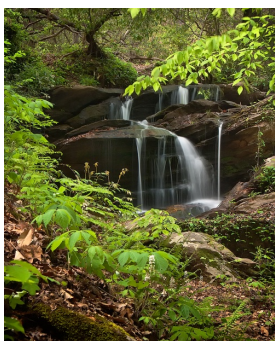

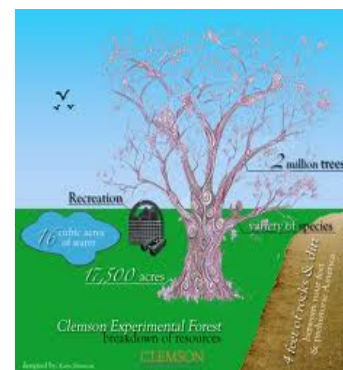
"The Story of our Clemson Forest How it came to be....What you can see"

Clemson University has been named "Tree Campus USA" for its dedication to campus forestry management and environmental stewardship from the non-profit foundation, Arbor Day, and is the only campus with a 17,500 acre forest adjacent to the campus.



Dr. Sill recently retired from teaching engineering at Clemson, but continues his long-term interest in the Clemson Forest. Over the years, he has made numerous presentations about the Forest and, for more than five years, has taught an Honors College course about the Forest. He will provide us with the history of this magical, beautiful, living laboratory, and the many opportunities it presents for the enjoyment of all who visit it.

A "Renaissance Man", Ben is a photographer, poet, collector of all things old, hybridizer of Bromeliads in his greenhouse, and bird watcher (with 1000 species of birds in his life list). He has also published three humorous books on birds.
